

1 Create a database

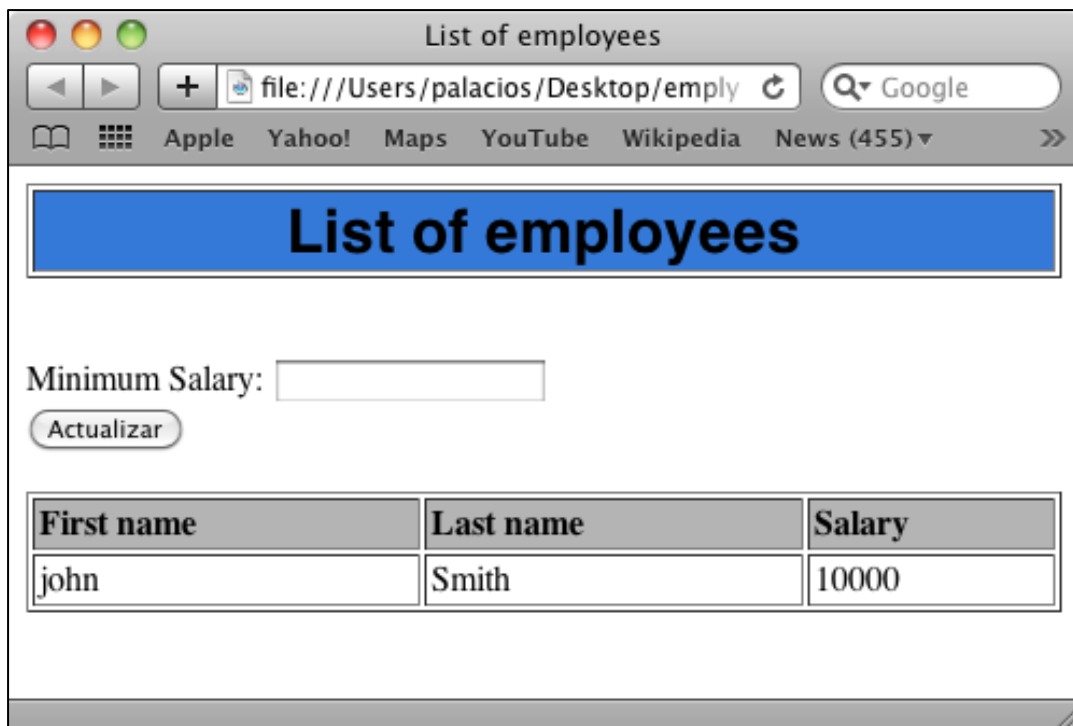
Use phpMyAdmin to create a database and one table called users.

Table users should contain three columns: first name (varchar), last name (varchar) and salary (double).

Fill up some sample data.

2 Create a web page

Use NVU (or Kompozer) editor to create the main page that contains a small form to read filter data, and a table to display the results.



3 PHP program

Convert the HTML file created before into a re-entrant PHP program (the form action is the same file).

Check that your table is updated according to the input salary.

Check if entering invalid salary values you can break your query.
